SUBJECT: Model R221 - differences from Model R210.

The R221 is a radio phonograph combination consisting of a 5 tube superheterodyne receiver and a G.I. Model 700 33/45 Triple Speed Automatic Record Changer. This model is manufactured in two versions 115 volts, 25 cycles and 115 volts, 60 cycles.

The R221 cabinet is basically the R210 cabinet with the record storage compartment moved to the side of the cabinet.

The electrical and mechanical components of the R221 receiver are identical to the R210 receiver. Refer to the R210 Service Manual for data on all parts other than the cabinet. For detailed information on the changer refer to the G.I. Model 700 33/45 Record Changer Service Manual.
